- The genebank started from the collection of more than 15,000 farmers' varieties of short-and long-grain rice in collaboration with the International Rice Research Institute (IRRI).
- More than 18,000 accessions are now conserved in the genebank.

- Some 42 modern varieties of rice in Laos are derived from material conserved in the genebank.
